### ROAD IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT

Between The Kalkaska County Road Commission and Boardman Township For the Year 2016/2017

This agreement, made and entered into between the Township Board of Boardman Township, Kalkaska County, Michigan, herein as Township and the Board of Kalkaska County Road Commission, referred to herein as Road Commission.

Whereas; the parties of the Township desire to improve the following road:

Butler Road From end of asphalt to Woodman Road

1.7 Miles

It is now therefore agreed, that the Kalkaska County Road Commission will perform the following:

A. Clear trees, ditch in various locations, Raise road in swamp areas, and add 5,500 tons of 23A gravel.

For the not to exceed cost of NINETY THOUSAND AND 0/100THS DOLLARS (\$90,000.00).

It is further agreed that Boardman Township will pay one hundred percent (100%) of the projected costs of labor, equipment and materials, not to exceed Ninety Thousand and 0/100ths Dollars (\$90,000.00). Fifty percent (50%) of the projected cost, estimated to be Forty Five Thousand and 00/100ths Dollars (\$45,000.00) is to be paid by the Township upon execution of this Agreement. Upon deposit of these funds, the Road Commission will program and complete the above improvements no later than June 1, 2017, unless such date is changed by mutual agreement of all parties.

It is further agreed upon that the remaining balance will be paid upon the completion of the contract.

## **ROAD IMPROVEMENT AGREEMENT**

Between The Kalkaska County Road Commission and Boardman Township For the Year 2016/2017 (cont.)

The parties recognize the projected cost can increase or decrease due to factors beyond the parties' control. In recognition of the risk, the Township agrees to approve the actual of labor, equipment and materials costs up to Ninety Thousand and 0/100ths Dollars (\$90,000.00). The Road Commission shall refund to the Township any surplus that may be applicable. Upon conclusion of the project, the Road Commission will present a final bill to the Township showing the actual costs or surplus. The parties agree to tender payment for the balance of the project cost and/or to refund the surplus amount within thirty (30) days of the final billing.
